

# Grand Canyon West Rim



Depart Las Vegas on a deluxe air conditioned motor coach with a guide that will keep you informed of the points of interest along this tour route. You cross over **The Mike O'Callaghan - Pat Stillman Memorial Bridge** otherwise known as the **Hoover Dam Bypass**. The construction cost of the bridge was approximately \$240 million dollars and it is located 1600 ft downstream from the Hoover Dam. The bridge links the US states of NV & AZ and offers a spectacular view of the Dam from high above. You will travel through the 900 year old Joshua Tree Forest and hear the history of the region's early inhabitants. When you arrive at the West Rim you will savor a deluxe lunch served by members of the Hualapai Indian Tribe. You will take a tour of the rim on the Hualapai shuttle stopping at all view points.



You have time for sight-seeing at Eagle Point, Guano Point and visit the Indian Village. Peer over the edge to view the Colorado River and take photos of this wonder of nature unblemished by modern man. Visit the glass bridge that is suspended more than 4000 feet above the Colorado river. Here you find a view that exceeds your imagination. Ticket to Glass Bridge to be obtained at bridge site. Before you leave, take time to see the authentic curios and art objects the craftsmen of the reservation have on display.
