

Las Vegas Old Fort & Springs Preserve

How Las Vegas

In 1844 explorer John C. Fremont stopped at the big spring known as Las Vegas (Spanish for "the meadows"). After he published a description of it travelers to California used it as a watering stop and in 1855 Mormon colonists built a fort here to link California and Utah. In 1905 the new railroad auctioned off lots to the public and that was the birth of modern Las Vegas.
