Next enjoy a waterside lunch at historical Calville Bay Marina. Stroll along the beach and docks and enjoy the many fish, ducks and fauna in the area. Our journey continues into the beautiful Black Mountains where youøll arrive at the øtop of the worldö for a view of a lifetime. Mysterious RogersøSprings is next where you can explore the waterfalls, reeds and palm trees at this true desert oasis. The best part of your trip is when you enter the Valley Of Fire, you see Aztec sandstone formations in fire red over 150 million years old. There are overwhelming valleys and incredible gorges with ancient Indian Petroglyphs, up close views of Elephant Rock, Seven Sisters Formations and a stone shelter built decades ago. Finally weøll travel through the Moapa Indian Reservation for a restful short drive back to Las Vegas
